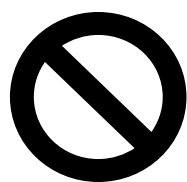


Camping at SSP!

Here's what you'll find when you arrive:

Each student is provided with the following items:

- ✓ an extra-long twin bed
- ✓ a desk and chair
- ✓ a chest of drawers
- ✓ a bookcase










You will also find:

- ✓ a smoke detector
- ✓ fixture to hang clothes on

Good ideas:

- ✓ over-the-counter medication (Tylenol, Benadryl, Pepto-Bismol etc.) - School nurse will be on staff to dispense these medications
- ✓ a calculator (if you have one)
- ✓ tennis racket or chess set if interested in playing
- ✓ 7-watt nightlight, if needed
- ✓ cell phone, *may not use in classes or assemblies* (not required, hall phones are available for student use,)
- ✓ hangers, *if needed (none are provided)*

Here's what you'll need to bring (these things are NOT provided):

- ✓ toilet paper 
- ✓ quarters (for vending and laundry machines) 
- ✓ bath mat & toiletries (hand soap, shampoo, tooth paste, shower gel, etc.) 
- ✓ towels, pillow, blanket & extra-long twin sheets 
- ✓ small trash can 
- ✓ detergent (if planning to do laundry) 
- ✓ notebook, pens, pencils 
- ✓ swim suit & beach towel (if interested in swimming)
- ✓ clothes & shoes: *see reverse side for dress code regulations.*
- ✓ any prescription/OTC medication you are taking (**must** give to school nurse at check-in in a sealed baggy) 
- ✓ **alarm clock!** - SSP staff will NOT wake

- ~~×~~ dangerous items (candles, pocket knives, flammables, etc)
- ~~×~~ appliances (mini-fridges, hotpots...)
- ~~×~~ stereos, computers, TVs, radios, or beepers (*only walkman/discman, MP3 Player/IPOD and clock radio are OK*)
- ~~×~~ over \$25 in cash, excluding quarters
