The following data are the South Carolina Governor's School for Science and Mathematics Fines and Fees Report for fiscal year 2019 – 2020 as directed by FY2020 Budget Proviso 117.73.

Authorizing Proviso: Budget Proviso 1.29 FY 2020

Amounts received by source:

Student Meal Fees and security deposit (1):	\$406,874
Summer Program Tuition (2):	\$ 2,000
Miscellaneous Revenue:	\$ 9,897

- 1) The school charged \$1,650 for the class of 2020 and \$1,800 for the class of 2021 to offset a partial cost of the meal plan. We also charge a \$100 security deposit which is refunded after graduation.
- 2) This is for summer camps for rising 8th, 9th and 10th graders.
- 3) Includes damaged book fees, vending machine revenue, etc.

Purpose for which the funds were expended:

The student meal fees were used to offset partially the cost of the meal program. Summer camp tuition was used to pay for faculty, staff, supplies, and room and board for the summer camps in 2019. Miscellaneous revenue was used to pay for damaged books, offset the cost of standardized tests, replace equipment in the resident halls, etc.

No funds were transferred to the General Fund or to another entity.
